When I then try to use ClipMate to return to my older Cyrillic text, it only displays it as ?????? it does not recognize it and thereby can't paste the proper text!!!

Unicode is required to properly capture and display non-ANSI character sets. We hope to release a version with full Unicode capability before year-end 2014.
